**COACH ASSESSMENT:** THE ROYALS RESPONDED WELL TO A SLOW START AND FINISHED THE FIRST HALF ON EQUAL TERMS IN RELATION TO THE SCORELINE BUT DOMINANT IN TERMS OF POSSESSION.
